Weight Loss	Poor Appetite

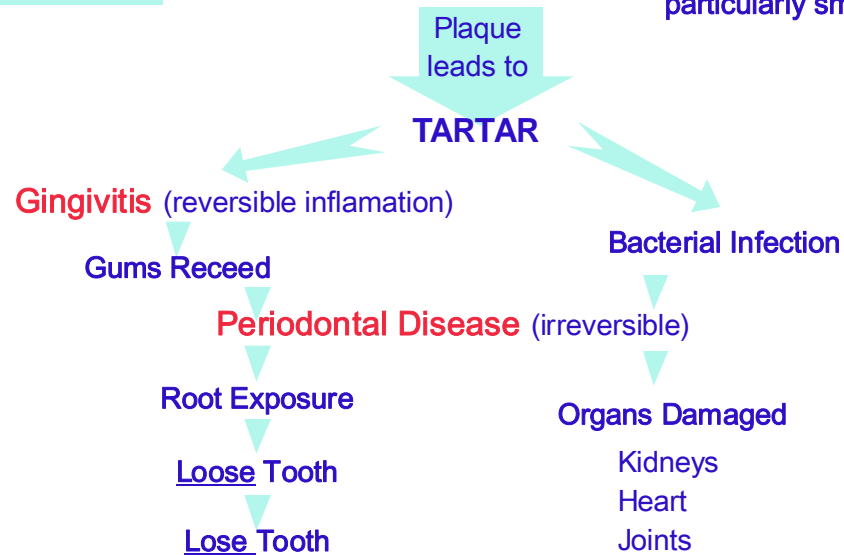
WHAT YOU CAN DO :

- * Test for FeLV / FIV periodically and stay up to date with Vaccinations
